

Solidarity *instead of* the "Integration law"

*Who says welcome,
has to enable the right to stay.*

Shortly before their summer break, the German parliament will take a vote on the so called "integration law". It shall enter into force in Mid July 2016. This new law will continue to restrict the rights of refugees. The "integration law" draws on the Asylum packages I and II, who lead to a gradual cutdown/degeneration of the right to Asylum.

The government publicly passes the law off as milestone of refugees' integration. If you have a look at the law's draft in detail, you will find the opposite: considering asylum politics, the law is a deprivation of the rights of refugees based on economizing the time to deal with every single case. "Integration" means coercion to participate in "working measures", enforced participation in state-controlled "integration courses" and excessive sanctions, if refugees are not in conformity with that.

Politicians allege that refugees are lazy and not willing to integrate, although a lot of refugees have no access to german courses, get no working permission, cannot move freely or chose their residency autonomously. With the new law, the government plays into the hands of racists, and wrongfully criminalizing refugees.

We want to protest together in the streets against the "integration law" and the deprivation of refugees' rights! We demand the stop of the stigmatization and coercive education of refugees! Working prohibitions and all forms of residential obligation ("Residenzpflicht") have to be abolished!

Let us demand after shouting "Refugees welcome":
THE RIGHT TO STAY FOR EVERYONE AND
WITHOUT RESTRICTIONS! STOP RACIST LAWS !
